Faculty Rep (Doctoral)

As a Doctoral Faculty Rep, you are the lead voice for your faculty, you will collaborate with the Academic Reps. You'll work closely with Faculty Senior Management to develop positive change for students within your faculty.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Work closely with Faculty/School Senior Management to develop ideas and escalate issues from your Doctoral Reps so they can be resolved in a timely manner.
- Collaborate with staff and contribute to discussion at Boards of Studies and Faculty/School Doctoral Studies Committees to help develop the educational priorities of the Faculty/School.

Additional Responsibilities

- Attend and contribute to regular Executive Committee meetings.
- Liaising with the Doctoral Reps within your Faculty/School and communicate emerging issues to the Exec Chair outside of meetings.
- Contribute towards SU events and campaigns related to academic issues within your Faculty/School and the University.
- Ensuring you read meeting papers and agendas in advance as well as consider policy change proposals on behalf of the Reps in your Faculty/School.
- Represent the doctoral student experience at an institutional level.
