What is Senate?

Senate is responsible for directing and regulating the academic work of the University. It is the universities highest level committee and discusses key issues impacting students across the university. Senate is chaired by the Vice Chancellor and its membership is made up of the Pro Vice-Chancellors, Deans of Faculty/School of Management, with several elected academic staff members.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Attend senate meetings and act as the representative for all students along with the SU President, SU Education Officer and the SU Postgraduate Officer.
- Chair Academic Exec, taking lead and guiding discussions on what is working well and what could be improved at University of Bath to improve the quality of teaching and learning for students
- Collaborate and liaise with Faculty Reps & the SU Officers to work on academic issues & campaigns.
