1. Planning next social/event

- We should therefore contact the Maths Dept. if we want to collaborate with them to any extent
- Those on the stalls will be: UGs doing projects (i.e. 3rd years doing projects),
 MMaths, PhDs, Lecturers

How we advertise:

- We have an option of doing a Paid Bar Committee decides no; people buy their own drinks
- Do we pre-book 200 people worth dinner assuming all 200 sell out?
- Release tickets in Batches?

- **Emily** to see if 120 can come to only drinks reception
- Emily to ask about VAT on the tickets
- **Emily** to ask Big Band how much to book them
