To underpin all of the above, we aspire to strike the most constructive, assertive and productive partnership between students and their university anywhere.

It should involve:

- ① A commitment to pre-induction research that enables teachers, professional services staff and other students to understand who is on each programme, as well as their needs and ambitions so that delivery can adapt to the students we have, not the students we'd like.
- 2 A new agreement between students and the University that starts from the principle that we should be able to exert our influence wherever a decision is made about us.

- 3 An agreement that centres the SU as the fosterer of leadership opportunities a clearing house that gives students confidence that their independent input can have impact, offering defined educational and career benefits in the process.
- 4 Extended premises for the SU that maximise space for us to learn, coordinate, discuss and plan initiatives and influence student life.
- **6** An annually agreed partnership agreement that sets out the University's and SU's joint commitments to improve the student experience over that year, beyond the Top Ten.
